

In Compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF) Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 03.08.2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act-2006 ('FRA', for Short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that **0.855 Ha.** of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **Executive Engineer, Construction Division, PWD B&R Branch, Rupnagar** (Name of User Agency) for widening of Ropar-Abiana- Nurpur Bedi Road from Km. 12.45 to Km.13.875, total length 1.425 Kms in Village-Madhopur to Abiana Kalan under Rupnagar Forest Division Distt. Rupnagar, Punjab (Under CRF Scheme) in the State of Punjab.

It is further certified that :-

- The complete process for identification & settlement of Rights under the FRA has been carried out in the entire **0.855 Hec.** forest area proposed for diversion. (Since there is no Schedule Tribes in State of Punjab as per Census 2011).
- The proposal does not involve recognized rights of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities.
