The legal status of the land proposed for C/o Helipad at Shawala is UPF Kansoli & DPF Khurach and recorded as "Charagah" in Revenue Record. The certificate for the same from your good office has been uploaded against additional information detail in online Part-II at Sr. No. 10.
2.	The documents as uploaded at column No. 13 of Part-I gives the detail of forest area only but does not give the detail of working circle, hence, complete copy giving the necessary detail be uploaded.	The document related to working plan is uploaded against additional information detail in Part-II at Sr. No. 13 by your good Office. Hence, the required information pertains to DFO Office Chopal.
3.	In reply to point No. 11, CA scheme is still not prepared for 1978 plants as asked by GoI instead of this scheme of 5060 plants over 2 Ha. area has been proposed which is not correct. Further, CA scheme is still not been prepared on current wage rates.	Pertains to DFO Office
4.	The observation No. 16 has still not been attended instead of	Pertains to DFO Office
