Camp Ajmer, the 11th August 1930

No. 1076-C/102-A/38.—The Chief Commissioner, Ajmer-Merwara, is pleased to publish the following consolidated and revised declaration for reserved forests in Ajmer-Merwara in supersession of all previous declarations published under the Ajmer Forest Regulation, 1874, section 3, namely:—

Musjid	24-93	<p>A tract of land comprising an area of about 24-93 acres and consisting wholly of Nazul land, demarcated by 15 pucca pillars. The boundary line measures all round about 65-50 chains. The boundaries of this tract are as follows:—</p> <p><i>North.</i>—From pillar No. 1 on the left side of the Ajmer-Nasirabad road the line proceeds for a distance of 13-5 chains south-east to pillar No. 5 on the ridge.</p> <p><i>East.</i>—From pillar No. 5, it continues for a distance of 7 chains south-east to pillar No. 7 on the boundary of Pachatpura village; then turns south to pillar No. 8, a distance of 3 chains; and then runs South West for a distance of 2 chains to pillar No. 9.</p> <p><i>South.</i>—From pillar No. 9 it descends for a distance of 10-8 chains to pillar No. 15 on the Ajmer-Nasirabad Road.</p> <p><i>West.</i>—From pillar No. 15 it follows the Ajmer-Nasirabad Road south-east for a distance of 23-2 chains to pillar No. 1 the starting point.</p>

NOTIFICATION

Jaipur, August 5, 1978

No. F.3(16)Rev/S/76. In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Rajasthan Forest Act (Rajasthan) ACT No. XII of 1953, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby declares the strips of lands whether under tree growth or not on either side of the metalled roads under control of PWD, transferred to the Forest Department for management, as per schedule appended herewith, to be protected forests and the provisions of Chapter IV of the said Act and the rules made thereunder to be applicable to them.

In further pursuance of the powers conferred by Section 30 thereof, the Governor of Rajasthan further declares that the trees, shrubs, grass and other vegetation growing on the said strips of protected forest are reserved with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Gazette and prohibits from the aforesaid date, the cutting, lopping, pollarding, uprooting, setting fire or causing damage to the vegetation, removal of any forest produce in the said forests and breaking up or clearing for cultivation or for buildings, for grazing of cattle or for any other purpose, of any land in the said forest.
