

JOINT SITE INSPECTION REPORT

A proposal has been submitted under the Indian Forest Conservation Act-1980 for use of forest land for non-forestry purposes. The subject envisages the use of forest land for **Construction of Water Supply Scheme (WSS) Sumbal Balla Surfraw in Comptt. 34/Sindh block Ganiwon by (PHE, Jal Shakti Department)**.. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by us on **03-07-2021**.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest land measuring **0.29 Hacs**. The land proposed by the User Agency is the barest minimum required for the project and also the area so proposed doesn't house any unique flora & fauna. The linear measurements and calculations of the site for forest area is as under:
