- All the material required for road work shall be brought from outside and no material shall be collected from Reserve forest or reserve land.
- For any kind of blasting and quarrying prior permission shall be obtained.
- All DGPS surveyed points shall be clearly demarcated on the field and proposed alignment shall be followed.
- Forest boundaries shall be clearly demarcated by erecting boundary pillars.
