1.	Project details :	
(i)	Short narrative of the Proposal and projects/scheme for which the forest land is required	Ground water level is continuously falling in many districts of Bihar state. These are the bells of danger, in time to come. Especially in South Bihar, due to scarcity of rain and excessive water scarcity, there is a crisis of water. To overcome this problem, it was decided that during the four months of the flood period, the water of the river Ganga gets wasted and flows into the Bay of Bengal. That water should be used for drinking water throughout the year and to improve ground water levels. Simultaneously, it was also decided that the water crisis in Rajgir, Gaya and Bodh Gaya should be removed in the coming time. Because these cities are very important from religious and tourism point of view and the arrival of many national and international tourists remains constant throughout the year. Therefore, Ganga water lift scheme was constructed to meet the demand of drinking water of these cities, with lifting of Ganga water through pipe line with a far-reaching thinking. In the months of July to October, water will be obtained from the Ganga River and it will be collected at nearby places of Gaya and Rajgir. The collected Ganga water will be purified through a water treatment plant, drinking water will be supplied to these cities throughout the year. Under this scheme, a reservoir is to be constructed near the Tetar Panchayat of Wazirganj block and water treatment plant with a small reservoir in the hills of Abgila near Gaya town. With this, the city of Gaya and Bodh Gaya will continue to get continuous drinking water throughout the year, as well as the ground water level of Gaya town will also improve.

With the construction of this reservoir, the ground water level of this region will improve, which will also benefit the rest of the forest. Abgila Small Reservoir cum Water Treatment Plant Area - After stone excavation in this area, there is a pit of about 25 meters, which is perfect for building small reservoirs. Also, being close to the city, it is also mentioned for water treatment plant.
