


JUSTIFICATION ON EMPLOYMENT LIKELY TO BE GENERATED

Bolani Ores Mines is an on-going Mining Project with all its ancillary activities operative since 1960 over 1321.45 ha.

The part of employment is covered under the SAIL policy as per the project affected people as per the requirement. In the present proposal there is no scope of employment generation, as it is evident that there is no alteration in total land utilization and the instant proposal is being submitted for seeking necessary approval for modification of Final Stage-II FC order to include additional 87.09 ha land (DGPS area of 86.43 Ha) recorded as forest as on/after 25.10.1980) in the diversion under Forest Conservation Act 1980 in compliance to Condition no-2(ii) of Stage-II approval granted vide letter no 8-17/1997-FC (pt.) Dt.12.11.2014.

During the phase of mine expansion of Bolani Ores Mines, substantial amount of employment and income are going to be created. A large portion of these is likely to trickle down to the local people. Besides this, it is expected that for regular operation of the project local people will get employment in various mining activities in accordance with their qualification, skill and experience. Besides direct employment, the project is expected to generate substantial indirect employment in semi-skilled labour, casual labour as also skilled labour in other sectors e.g. in the small scale industrial units and service centres etc. which are existing at present and also expected to come in the vicinity of the project. The indirect employment and income effects are likely to be much larger than the direct effects of the project. Overall assessment of the employment and income effects indicate that the expansion project is likely to have strong positive direct as well as indirect impact on employment and income generation.
