Decision Taken: As the details regarding the disposal of bio-medical waste were not made available to the Standing Committee by the State Government officials, the Standing Committee decided to defer the proposal to the next meeting.

67.5.13 Proposal for use of 8.1872 ha of forestland from Great Himalayan National Park for construction of 11KV HT Line to the Un-electrified Village. Shagore, Shakti & Maror in Banjar Block Distt. Kullu, Himachal Pradesh.

The Standing Committee was informed that the proposal is for use of 8.1872 ha of forestland from Great Himalayan National Park for construction of 11kV HT Line to the Shagore, Shakti, & Maror Villages which are currently unelectrified in Banjar Block Distt. Kullu, Himachal Pradesh.

The proposal has been recommended by the Chief Wild Life Warden, State Board for Wild Life and the State Government.

The Chief Wild Life Warden, Himachal Pradesh informed that out of 8.1872 ha of the required land, 4.65 ha is located in the Great Himalayan National Park, 3.07 ha is located in adjoining Sainj Wildlife Sanctuary and 0.46 ha falls in ESZ. He said that the project will electrify about 300 households. He informed that the user agency will use covered conductors and therefore, the project will not have any adverse effect on avifauna. He said that the user agency has submitted a mitigation plan for the project.

Decision Taken: After discussions, the Standing Committee decided to recommend the proposal subject to the following conditions:

1. The User Agency shall implement the mitigation plan submitted by them.
2. The land below the transmission line shall be managed as per the management plan prepared specifically for the area so that fodder for herbivores is made available.
3. An annual compliance certificate on the stipulated conditions shall be submitted by the project proponent to the Chief Wild Life Warden and an annual compliance certificate shall be submitted by the Chief Wild Life Warden to Government of India.
