With reference to the subject cited above, I would like to inform you that as per Geo Coordinates and field survey, it is seen that the proposed natural gas pipe line passes through Eco-Sensitive Zone of Amchang and Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary from the GPS Co-ordinates N 26°12'29.7156" E 91°51'36.7394" to N 26°13'41.8371" E 91°56'11.2736" of Amchang Wildlife Sanctuary and GPS Co-ordinate N $26^{9}09'52.72"$ E $92^{0}00'04.43"$ to N $26^{9}08'48.58"$ E $92^{0}00'00.61"$ of Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary, as per the report submitted by the Range Forest Officer, Amchang Wildlife Range and Pobitora Wildlife Range.
