

Site Inspection Report By Arvind Kumar Singh, Conservator of Forests, Chitrakootdham Circle, Banda on 15-06-2018

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal named FP/UP/ROAD/25036/2017 has been received by this office from P.W.D. Department, Nirman Khand-1, Banda for dirversion under (FCA-1980) of 31.58 ha. of Forest land non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for four-lane widening of road from Naraini to Kalinjar road from Ch-35.00 Km to Ch-60.825 Km and from 0.00 to 1.500 on Kalinjar to Baghelbari Road in Forest and wild life Division Banda, District-Banda-U.P. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated 15-06-2018

On inspection of the site it is found that land required by the user agency is a RF/unclassed/ protected forest measuring 31.58 Ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
