Further on construction of these Reservoirs, water will be available in Reservoirs throughout the year and it will cater the drinking water needs to the wild animals even in summer season also. Further on construction of these reservoirs water table in surrounding forests will be increased. The land proposed for diversion for construction of Balaji & Mallimadugu reservoir is bearest minimum. Hence recommended.
