

Site Inspection Report of the Chief Conservator of Forests, Central Circle, Pasighat in respect of proposal for diversion of 65.32 Ha. of forestland for construction/Improvement of Migging-Tuting Road from Class 9 to NHDL specification road from design chainage 15.00 Km to 35.134 Km for a length of 20.134 Km under 105 RCC/HQ761 BRTF/HQ CE (P) Brahmark in Upper Siang District of Arunachal Pradesh.

Site inspection of construction/improvement of Migging-Tuting Road stretch from 15.0 Km to 35.134 Km under Yingkiong Forest Division of Arunachal Pradesh was carried out on 30.09.2022 & 01.10.2022. The area where the road stretch is to be constructed falls within Yingkiong Forest Division. The representative of the user agency (BRTF) and field officer of Yingkiong Forest Division accompanied the undersigned during the visit.

Following observation are made based on site inspection :-

1. The proposed area for construction of Migging-Tuting Road stretch from 15.00 Km to 35.00 Km does not form any part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Bio-sphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor etc.
2. No activity in violation of FC Act'1980 was noticed at the time of inspection as no work has been started.
3. No endangered flora and fauna were noticed at the time of inspection.
4. No historical site etc. was noticed to be falling under the proposed area.
5. The requirement of forestland as proposed by the user agency (BRTF) was found to be unavoidable and at the barest minimum for the project.

Proposed construction/improvement of Migging-Tuting road stretch from 15.00 Km to 35.134 Km is essentially required for strategic defense point of view and it will also benefit the local people for proper connectivity and for their economic development.
