SITE INSPECTION REPORT

(Highlighting facts about proposal as required under column-11 of Part-II)

- 1. A proposal has been received by this office from 4 Laning of Nasri-Ramban Section of NH 44 (old NH1A) at CRITICAL LOCATIONS between km 130 and km 151 in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir for diversion of forest under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for nonforestry purposes. The project envisages diversion of 1.3089 hectares of Forest land (Revenue forest) for the proposal. The site inspection of the spot involved in the proposal has been done by the undersigned on 12-03-2022.
- On inspection of the site, it is found that the project requires diversion of 1.3089 ha of Revenue Forest falling of Tehsil Ramban District Ramban for 4 Laning of Nasri-Ramban Section of NH 44 (old NH1A) at CRITICAL LOCATIONS between km 130 and km 151 in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir.
- The requirement of the forest land as proposed by the User Agency in Col-2 Part-I is unavoidable and bare minimum required for the project.
- No Rare/Endangered/Unique species of flora and fauna in the area during the visit.
- 5. No violation of the Act has been carried out by the User Agency at the site as which shall be allowed only after clearance of the proposal by the competent Authority.
- 6. No tree/pole is coming under the alignment of the project which requires felling
- 7. (b) Specific recommendation for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal :- Diversion of 1.3089 ha revenue forest land for 4 Laning of Nasri-Ramban Section of NH 44 (old NH1A) at CRITICAL LOCATIONS between km 130 and km 151 in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir is recommended for forest clearance under section-2 (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 with terms and conditions as mentioned by State Govt/MoEF&CC in favour of National Highway Authority of India.
