

Field Inspection Notes of District Forest Officer, Peddapally on diversion of 1.345 Ha of forest land for Construction of pipelines and other structures for providing water supply to Ramagundam Fertilizer and Chemicals limited (RFCL), Ramagundam from Yellampally Project - in favour of Superintending Engineer, RWS&S Circle, Karimnagar.

I along with Forest Range Officer, Peddapally and concerned staff have inspected the proposed diversion area for Construction of pipelines and other structures for providing water supply to Ramagundam Fertilizer and Chemicals limited (RFCL), Ramagundam from Yellampally Project on 07.08.2018. The proposed pipeline is passing through the Compt.No.707,708,709&710 Thakkalapally and Kannala Reserve Forests in Peddapally Range of this division. The details of area is as follows.

1. Compartment No. 707&708 of Thakkalapally RF to an extent of 0.232 Ha.
2. Compartment No. 709&710 of Kannala RF to an extent of 1.113 Ha.



The total area required for diversion in Peddapally division for Construction of pipelines and other structures for providing water supply to Ramagundam Fertilizer and Chemicals limited (RFCL), Ramagundam from Yellampally Project is **1.345 Ha.**

In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree species, protected archaeological, Heritage site, defense establishment or any other important monument are found. The area is having different types of vegetation, having 0.1 to 0.3 density.

The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project.

No work in violation of the Forest Conservation Act 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency.
