It has also been found that due to construction of proposed road no major impact will occur for soil erosion and flora & fauna. Further, the user agency has also undertaken to pay the cost of Soil Moisture

		Conservation Plan, in which all the protection, conservation and mitigation measures shall be included. Keeping in view the above, the above subjected road is recommended for diversion of land in Protection cum- habitation working circle.

However, as per the site Inspection Report, no violation has been reported by the concerned DFO. However, as per your query the DCF Chamba has also visited the proposed road area on dated 20- 06-2023, which is uploaded on the portal against Part-I by UA and in Part-II by DFO Chamba against additional information please.
