Subject: Regarding Forest Diversion Proposal of Widening and Curve Improvement on Existing Road Alignment on Kishangarh-Hanumangarh Mega Highway Project at Village-Chakbeer, Tehsil-Roopangarh, District-Ajmer (Rajasthan)

Sir,

Existing Kishangarh-Hanumangarh Road is passing through the Chakbeer- Sursura Protected forest block and as per revenue record Existing ROW is available 22 meter to 27 meter in forest area.

As per land Records this road even exists before 1980 and have separate khasra no 16 & 17 measuring 33 Bigha & 7 Biswa. We have done the widening within ROW.

There is requirement of Curve improvement in ChakbeerSursura Forest block to reduce the Road Accident Cases; hence we have applied for 0.84 hectare forest land Diversion Proposal under FCA Act, 1980 for Curve improvement.

The proposal was Forwarded from your office to Concern Deputy Conservator of Forest, Ajmer (Rajasthan) but after review of the proposal Deputy Conservator of Forest, Ajmer have raised the EDS Letter that user agency have applied Forest Diversion Proposal only for Curve improvement while Entire forest block road length should be considered for area calculation.

As per revenue record Ownership of the road belong to Public Works Department, Ajmer but as per directions of DCF we are applying the Forest Diversion Proposal for 4.470 hectare area inspite of the fact that existing road is entered in our khata of revenue records.
