


Justification Letter

The PMGSY Road from Kanthan to Sawalakot-II has been sanctioned under Package No. JK14-559, Phase-XI, Stage-I, Length = 26.76 Kms. In which 17.975 Kms road length is passing through Forest Area, which involves 10.785 Hec. area for the construction of road and 3.17 Hec. area is involved for 29 nos. Dumping Yards, and these dumping yards are proposed on an average of two Dumping Yards per Km. of the road length.

Keeping in view to avoid the agricultural land and damages to the forest land on down side of hill slope and to provide the better protection to the small Dumping Yards on steep hill slopes is the purpose to keep the no. of Dumping Yards on higher side, because during construction of road in hilly terrain there is no scope available to control the excavated muck on hill slopes, except to provide the small Dumping Yards at suitable locations to protect the forest and agricultural land in adjoining area.

It is also pertinent to mention here that the disposal of muck generated in Non Forest Area is to be disposed off in Non Forest Land itself and the muck generated in the forest area to be dumped in the proposed location which has already been identified during the joint verification by the User Agency with Forest Department.

Hence Justification Certificate is issued keeping in view the safety of Forest/vegetation and agricultural land on down side of hill slope along the alignment of road.
