

UNDERTAKING FOR SUBMISSION OF GRAM SABHA(S) CONSENT

In Compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India, letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) Dated 5th February, 2013 wherein MoEF issued guidelines on "Proposal seeking prior approval of Central Government under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for projects like construction of roads, canals, laying of pipelines/optical fibers and transmission lines etc., where linear diversion of use of forest land in several villages are involved, unless recognized rights of PTG/PAC are being affected are exempted from requirement of obtaining consent of the concerned Gram Sabha(s) as stipulated in clause (c) read with clause (b), (e) and (f) in second para of this Ministry's said letter dated 03.08.2009," we hereby certify that our proposal for laying of Underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) does not involve recognized rights of Primitive tribal Groups/Pre-Agricultural Communities (PTG/PAC).

We also undertake to obtain and submit the consent of concerned Gram Sabha (s), if it is found otherwise, at any point of time.
