


Brief Note on Nuclear Power Project at Kovvada (v)
of Srikakulam district.

The Nuclear Power Project is situated near the sea coast. Rehabilitation and Resettlement Colony for the project affected areas is proposed in Dharmavaram Sy.No.551 & 553. The fishermen community have requested to allot the land near to the sea coast for taking out their livelihood. Accordingly, the Joint Inspection Team has been constituted in the case along with Spl. Dy. Collector, Kovvada, Revenue Divisional Officer, Srikakulam, the then Divisional Forest Officer, Srikakulam, Assistant Director of Survey & Land Records, Srikakulam, Tahsildar, Etcherla for identification of suitable land along with Project level committee and the PDFs. The Joint inspection team inspected the land to an extent of Ac 238.52 cents in Sy.No.21 in Thamada (v) for transfer to the Forest Department as a substitute to Dharmavaram lands for this purpose.



In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 [as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014, Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2014, and Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2016] it is certified that 82.12 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of District Collector, Srikakulam (name of user agency) for Rehabilitation & Resettlement colony for PDFs Kovvada Nuclear Power Project falls within the jurisdiction of Kovvada (v) of Etcherla mandal of Srikakulam district.

It is further certified that:

- a. the complete process of recognition and vesting of forest rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 82.12 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion.
- b. the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA, 2006 have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it.
- c. the proposed are does not involve recognized right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural communities.
