- A relative height e.g., &r, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
- Tanks, shown dry in this area usually contain water from July to September.
- Cart-Tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season.

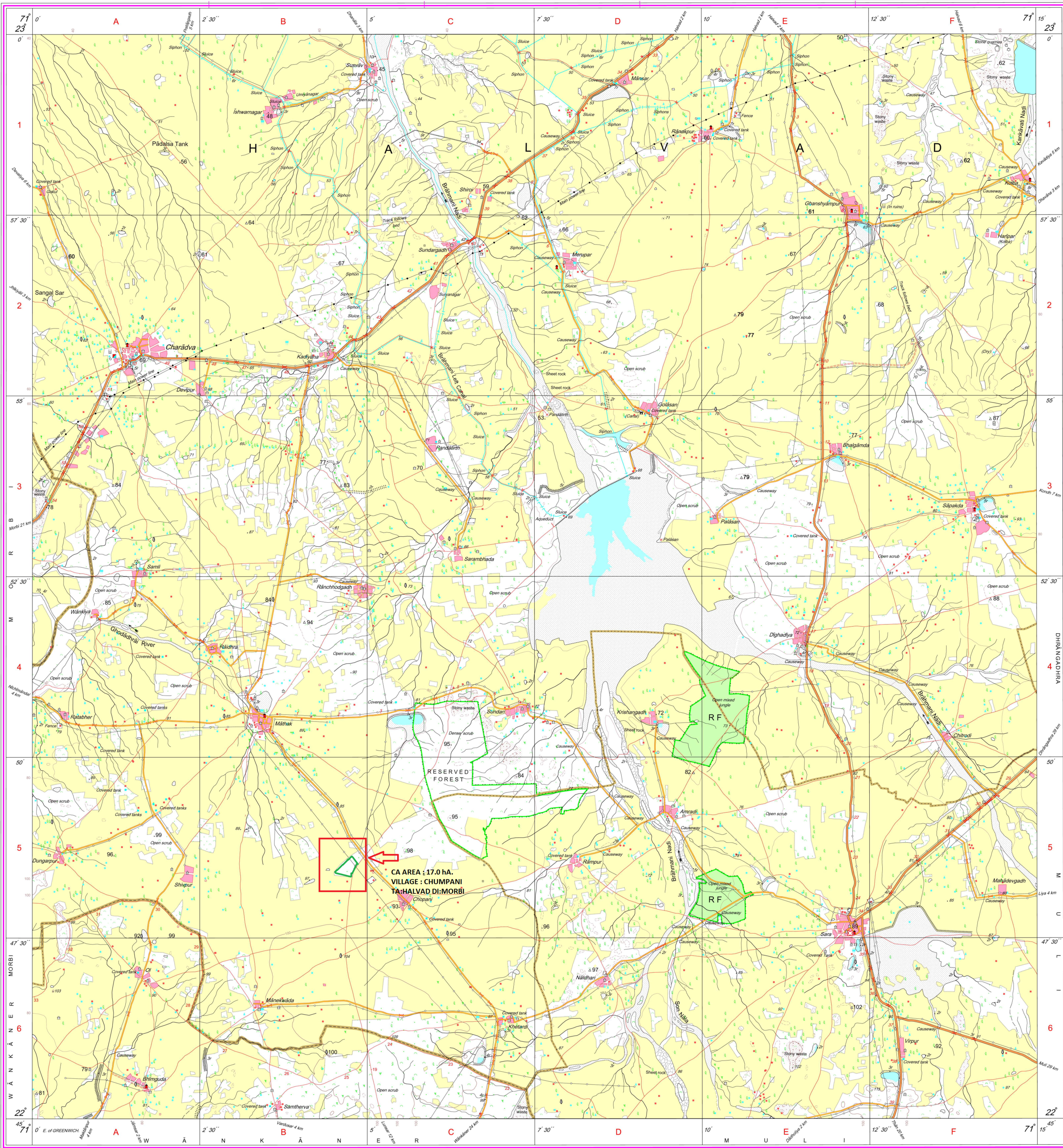
