Site inspection report of diversion of 1.987 Ha. Forest land for Setting up of Police / CRPF Camp for Anti-Extremist Operation duties in Inter State Border.

I have inspected the said area in Charla Range on 16.03.2022. The proposed CRPF Camp is situated in the midst of the Charla Reserve forest area near Unjupalli village in Compt.No.74A of Oddipeta North beat of Oddipeta section of Charla Range. The details are as shown below.

The User Agency proposed for 1.987 Ha., for the diversion of the forest land for deployment of Police/CRPF camp near Unjupalli village of Oddipeta North beat of Oddipeta section in Charla Range, Bhadrachalam Division of Bhadrachalam District, Kothagudem for anti extremist Operations duties in the interstate bordering areas. Therefore the diversion of the forest land for the above proposed project is recommended for 1.987 Ha.

The proposed area contains miscellaneous tree growth with medium girth class trees and few valuable timber trees are present. Project does not cause any harm to the local flora and fauna. The proposed project for anti extremist operations of Police/CRPF forces in left wing extremism affected areas.

The site proposed for diversion is falling in the forest type of Southern Tropical Dry Deciduous Forests (5A) as per Champion and Seth classification. The vegetation is of miscellaneous type with predominant species of Mitragnya parvifolia, Anogeissus latifolia, Tectona Grandis, Terminalia arjuna, Terminalia arjuna etc., The type of soil is Red. The average crop density is 0.40. The proposed site for diversion is plain and not vulnerable to erosion.
