In Compliance of Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (Pt) Dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of Settlement of Rights under Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non forest purposes, it is certified that for the 2<sup>nd</sup> renewal of Indaram Mining Lease over 929.29 Ha of forest land involving 15.18 Ha for surface use in Compartment Nos. 699, 703, 706, 709 711, and 714 in Indaram Reserve Forest Mancherial Range and Division in Mancherial District proposed to be diverted in favour of General Manager, SCCL Srirampur Area.

It is further certified that:

1. The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 929.29 Ha of forest land involving 15.18 Ha. of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee, Gram Sabha, Sub-Division Level Committee and the District Level committee are enclosed.
2. The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabhas of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
3. The concerned Gram Sabhas have certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificates issued by the Gram Sabhas of Jaipur and Naspur Mandals are enclosed.
4. The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabhas present.

5. The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it.
6. The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) of the FRA.
