

reference are as below:

Sr. No.	Point	Reply
1.	Instead of proper digital map google earth map has been provided for the area proposed for diversion in hard copy as well as uploaded at Part I C iv.	Digital map has been uploaded.
2.	Since village Gharanu has ST population, proper FRA Certificate as per performa is required	It is intimated that FRA certificate which was earlier attached with the folder was on old format which is not admissible now. To obtain FRA certificate now, it is a lengthy process. Firstly, it is to be obtained from local Gram Panchyat i.e. Vashist, then is to be processed at Sub Divisional level and then finally, it will issued by Deputy Commissioner. NOC from Gram Sabha can be obtained only when official Gram Sabha meeting will be held on April 24, 2016. As and when NOC received from Gram Sabha FRA certificate will be submitted/uploaded accordingly.
3.	As per column 8 i Part II 0.0942 ha area has been mentioned as wildlife area whereas in column 8 ii it is mentioned that the area proposed for diversion does not form part of National Park or Sanctuary. May clarify and if required may obtained clearance from National Boar of Wildlife.	DFO Wild life Kullu vide his office letter No. FCA/5050 dated 01-02-2016 ( <b>Copy attached</b> ) has informed that the area of 0-0942 hac. Proposed for diversion is falls in R/3 Dana Bihal (Part of Nature Park Manali) not a part of Wild Life Sanctuary. The land proposed for diversion is a part of Nature Park Manali under the administrative control of DFO Wild Life Kullu, hence the clearance from National Board of Wild Life is not required.
4.	At page 29 of hard copy one tree shown present on the area proposed for diversion but in online Part II column 4 No. tree has been shown.	There is one tree involved. The matter regarding online Part II column pertains to your office.


