
In inviting a reference to the letter on the subject cited, it is to intimate you that, the points raised therein have been clarified and essential documents sought are also attached as indicated in the table below:-

(i)	In the above proposal total area mentioned is of 279 acre, but in the non forest land required for the project is written '0'. In Annexure-(xvi) submitted along with Diversion Proposal, recommendation of 237 acre land in favour of M*/s Shyam Metalics & Energy Ltd. is mentioned in addition to earlier recommended 193.87 acre by IPICOL vide letter No.2821, dt.17/09/08. The correct total land acquired for the project and its breakup (forest land and non forest land) be submitted.	<p>1- The User agency had applied for allotment of 657 Ac.(265.88 ha) land for its project at Rengali.</p> <p>2- Initially recommended by IDCO:- 193.87Ac. (v)	Details of cost-benefit analysis for the project must be submitted as per now revised guidelines.	As per the Guidelines issued by Government of India, MoEF, on 1 <sup>st</sup> August, 2017, Cost Benefit Analysis is not required for proposals involving forest land up to 20 Ha.
(vi)	Copy of the Environment clearance under Environmental (Protection) Act 1986 must be submitted. If the project does not require the Environmental clearance the required certificate from the competent authority must be submitted.	The Copy of the EC has been attached to the proposal as Annexure- xi, page 49 to 56. The copy of extension dated, 2 <sup>nd</sup> December, 2016 is enclosed.
(vii)	The required FRA certificate for the entire forest land from the competent authority must be submitted.	The competent authority has been moved for issue of such a certificate and the matter is under process. The user agency has submitted an undertaking at Annexure-x, Page-48.
(viii)	Details of land identified for Compensatory Afforestation with detailed project at the current wage rate and required maps and documents must be prepared and submitted.	The Compensatory Afforestation Scheme has been prepared a copy of which is enclosed as Annexure-17.
(ix)	The joint enumeration list in forest and non forest land duly authenticated by the concerned forest and revenue officials must be submitted.	The copy of the tree enumeration report prepared jointly by the Revenue Inspector, Rengali and the Forest Range Officer, Rengali as communicated by the Tahasildar Rengali in his letter No.85, dated 08.02.2019 is enclosed as Annexure-18
(x)	All the required documents, maps and certificate duly authenticated by the competent authority must be annexed properly with page number in the check-list for the processing of the diversion proposal and site inspection.	All the required documents, Maps and certificates duly authenticated by the competent authority are enclosed with the proposal with proper page numbers in the Check-list.
