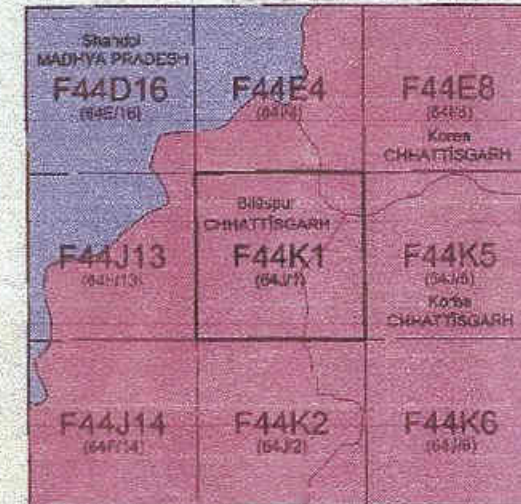


SURVEYSITE OF VILLAGE KESLA SUPERIMPOSE ON TOPOSHEET

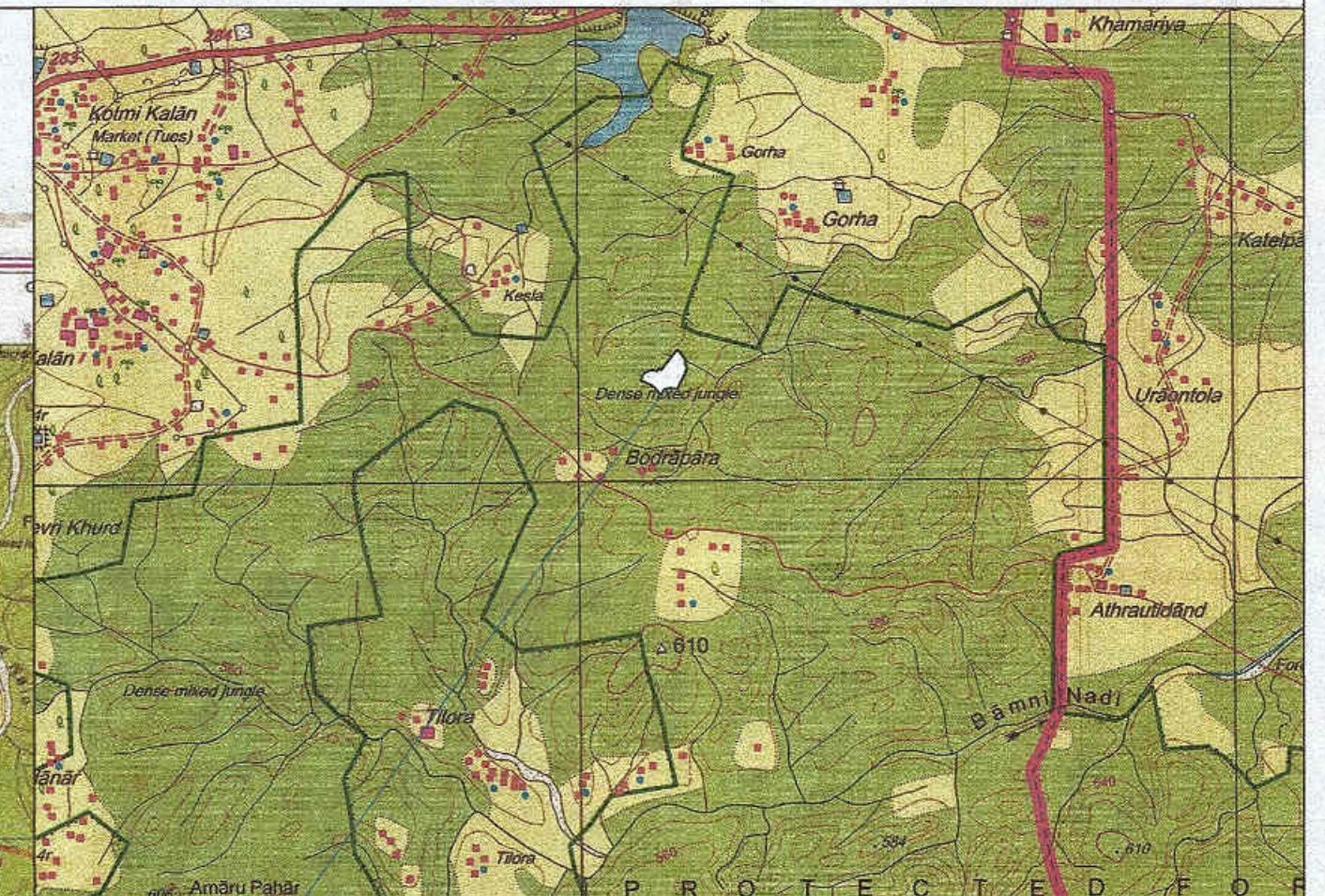
