In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India bearing letter no. 11-09/98-FC (pt) dated 28th October, 2014, It is certified that 10.184 hectares of protected forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of Uttar Pradesh Public Works department (UPPWD), Lucknow (UP) for Improvement and Widening of existing Nanau-Dadau Road (MDR 82W) at villages Nanau, Pilkhana, Sikandarpur, Jalali, Azadpur, Paharipur, Khargupura, Datavali, Barla, Tikta and Sihawali in Aligarh district.

It is further certified that the forest land proposed to be diverted is a plantation which was notified as 'forest' less than 75 years prior to the 13th day of December, 2005 and is located in villages having no recorded population of Schedule Tribes, as per Census-2001 and the Census-2011.
