

**“Execution of National Optical Fiber Network (NOFN) Project.
Kamareddy District, Telangana State.”**

Objectives and Scope


- M/s Bharat Broadband Network Ltd. (BBNL) has taken up Laying of optical Fiber cable in Banswada division Kamareddy District, Telangana State as per the directive of the Government of India.
- Government of India has approved National Optical Fiber Network (NOFN) project to connect 2, 50,000 GPs across the country, utilizing existing PSU’s infrastructure of BSNL, POWERGRID & RAILTEL by laying incremental fiber required to create the network.
- A tripartite agreement is signed between Department of Telecommunication GOI, BBNL and A.P. State Govt. earlier, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh issued a GO No: 18 dated 17.10.13 for free Right of Way permission to M/s BBNL for laying OFC along State Highways & Roads. Now the Information technology and Communications department of Govt. Of Telangana has issued a letter Lr.No.10-9/ITE&C/COMM/NOFN/2014/12, Dated: 15-12-2014, for free ROW permission for Execution of NOFN by Power grid Corporation Of India Limited on behalf of BBNL.


Need of the Project
