Site inspection Report of Dr.B.Chandrasekhar, SFS, Divisional Forest Officer, SPSR Nellore in Venkatagiri Range on 10-04-2017

Diversion of forest land in Mambattu RF for providing approach road from IP Mambattu Phase-I to IP Mambattu Phase-II, Tada Mandal, SPSR Nellore District:

I have inspected the proposed diversion area of Mambattu RF in Compartment no.165 Sulurpeta Beat in Sulurpeta Section on 10-04-2017. The proposed approach road enters in Compt.No.165 in Mambattu RF at N13.65199102° E79.99421306° and end at N 13.65117193° to 79.98297325°. Till now the user agency has not taken up any work in forest land.

The area is plain and no trees are present in the proposed diversion area. The density of the diversion area is 0.1 (Eco-Class-IV Tropical Thorn open scrub forest). The proposed diversion area does not fall in any Wild Life Sanctuary/ Eco-sensitive Zone / Protected Forest. Chainlink fencing is required on both side of the proposed road so as to protect the Wild Animals and prevent the encroachments. No rare and endangered unique species of flora and fauna in the proposed diversion area and not vulnerable for erosion.

The CA area which is identified adjacent to Mambattu RF in Sy.No.327 of Attivaram Village, Ozili Mandal over an extent of 2.44 ha is suitable for raising of Miscellaneous. The CA area was conducted DGPS Survey and also authenticated by the GIS cell. Accordingly, the CA scheme is prepared over an extent of 2.44 ha and arrived an amount of Rs. 21.176 lakhs.
