

I submit that I proceeded to Punugodu, Kanigiri Mandal to enquire in to the facts whether the proposed new B.G rail way line from Nadikudi to Srikalahasti involves any recognised rights of the primitive Tribal groups and pre agricultural communities. I was there in Punugodu Reserve forest at 2.00 Pm on 08-02-2016.

Sri P.M.D Arifkhan Deputy Range Officer, Kanigiri, Sri B.Ch.Nagaiah Forest Beat Officer Kanigiri and Sri Basheer Ahmad Assistant Beat Officer Kanigiri accompanied me and assisted me to locate the area of the proposed new B.G rail way line in Punugodu Reserve Forest.

I submit that the proposed new B.G rail way line enters the punugodu Reserve forest at station number 69 & 70 from the northern side and ends at station number 46 & 47 towards the southern side. As per the report of the forest range officer kanigiri the area to be diverted is arrived to 14.02 Ha with a length of 2.47 Kms. Punugodu village is located 4 Km away from the Reserve forest.

I submit that I again proceed that punugode and consulted the sarpanch grama panchayat punugodu and Village Revenue Officer, Punugodu for details on 16-02-2016. The Village Revenue Officer Punugodu village and sarpanch of Punugodu grama panchayat stated in writing that the proposed new B.G rail way line from Nadikudi to Srikalahasti does not incur any lose to the properties of the tribal people dwelling in punugodu grama panchayat. They stated after verifying the revenue records.

I submit that the proposed new B.G rail way line does not involve any recognised rights of the primitive Tribal groups and pre agricultural communities. It does not involve any right of the Tribal people regarding lands under the ROFR act 2006.
