

CERTIFICATE FOR MINIMUM USE OF FOREST LAND

Government of Madhya Pradesh vide their letter no 9402/Auction/Geology/F.No.3/2019-20 dated 5 July 2019 have issued Notice Inviting Tender in exercise to the power conferred by Section 10(B) and Section 11 of the Amended Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act 2015 and in accordance with Mineral (Auction) Rules 2015 to auction Bunder Diamond Block for grant of Mining Lease (ML). The block is spread over an area of 364 Ha in Buxwaha Tehsil of Chhatarpur District in Madhya Pradesh, the entire Mining lease areas falls in Buxwaha Protected Forest.

Essel Mining & Industries Limited (EMIL) have participated in the auction process of Bunder Diamond block and emerged as Preferred Bidder on conclusion of the process. Letter of Intent (LoI) for grant of ML over the proposed area of Bunder Diamond block was issued in favor of EMIL on 19 December 2019 vide letter vide letter no. F 3-26/2019/12/1. The same has been accepted by EMIL on 24 December 2019.

EMIL is now applying for Forest clearance for the project and certifies that the forest area involved for the project and applied in the Forest Diversion proposal is unavoidable and barest minimum forest area is considered for application of Forest Clearance (364.0 Ha of ML area $+ \sim 11.593$ Ha Approach Road $+ \sim 6.537$ Ha for Nala Diversion = around 382.131 Ha).
