SCHEDULE
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(to accompany consent No. KSPCB/RO(KWR)/CONSENT / SG/ 827 Dated)

I. TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL OF EFFLUENTS UNDER THE WATER ACT.

1. The discharge from the premises of the applicant shall pass through the terminal manhole / manholes where from the Board shall be free to collect samples in accordance with the provisions of the Act or Rules made there under.
2. The daily quantity of domestic effluent and washings effluent discharge shall not exceed the limits as indicated in the table below.

Sl. No.	Description of the effluents	Daily quantity of discharge in KL	Tolerance Limits	Frequency of monitoring
1	Domestic Effluents	150 LPD	-----	-----

3. The industry shall treat the domestic wastewater from the factory in septic tank with soak pits no overflow from the soak pit is allowed. The septic tank and soak pit shall be designed as per IS 2470 Part-I and Part -II.
4. The applicant shall discharge the effluents only to the place mentioned in the consent order.
5. There shall not be any generation of trade effluent from the unit at any point of time.

II. DISCHARGE OF EMISSIONS UNDER THE AIR ACT

There shall not be any source of air pollution and if the applicant is intended to install any air pollution sources then, the prior consent shall be obtained from the Board.

III. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. The applicant shall provide water meters for every source of water and shall submit the Cess returns regularly as required under Water Cess Act before 5th of every month in the prescribed form.
2. The Applicant shall display flow diagram of the pollution control system at the site.
3. The treatment unit site and the entire premises shall be always kept clean. The inspection chambers, outlets, flow measuring points should made easily approachable.
4. The applicant shall not change, or alter quality or quantity or the rate of discharge or temperature or the route of discharge with out the previous consent of the Board.
5. The applicant shall promptly comply with all orders and instructions issued from time to time by the Board or any other Officers of the Board duly authorized in this behalf.
6. The applicant shall display the consent granted in a prominent place for perusal of the perusal of the inspecting Officers of the Board.
7. The applicant shall provide alternate power supply sufficient to operate all Pollution control equipments utilized by the applicant to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of this consent.
8. The applicant is heirs, legal representatives or assigns shall have no claims what so ever to the continuation or renewal of this consent after expiry of the period of consent.
9. The applicant shall forth with keep the Board informed of any accident of unforeseen act or event of any poisonous noxious or polluting matter or emissions are being discharged into stream or well or air as a result of such discharge, water or air is being polluted.
10. The Board reserves the right to review, impose additional conditions, revoke, change or alter terms and conditions of this consent.
11. If any complaints are received against the unit for establishing / operation of industrial activity by neighboring habitat / local people or any organization and if the same is proved, then the applicant shall closed down the establishing activities / operation of the industry immediately and shift from the said location with prior CFE of the Board.
12. This consent is issued as per Consent Committee Meeting proceedings dated 11-07-2012.

IV. Solid Waste Management.

1. The applicant shall dispose the solid waste in the form of left over food items to municipality without causing pollution to Environment & nuisance.


V. Noise Pollution Control:

1. The applicant shall take steps to control noise levels so as to maintain ambient air quality standard in respect of noise as laid down under the Air Act 1981.

VI. Monitoring and reporting:

1. The applicant shall maintain log books to reflect the working conditions of pollution control systems and also self monitoring results and keep it open for inspection.
