CERTIFICATE FOR NO OTHER ALTERNATIVE NON FOREST LAND

(Justification report)

The entire NPCIL project is situated near the sea coast. Regarding Rehabilitation and Resettlement for the project affected areas the fisher men community has requested to allot the land near the sea coast for eking out their lively hood.

Accordingly, a joint inspection team has been constituted in this case along with these officers i.e. Special Deputy Collector, Kovvada, Revenue Divisional Officer, Srikakulam, Division Forest Officer, Sriakakualm Assistant Director of Survey and Land Records, Srikakulam and Tahsildar Etcherla for identification of suitable land along with project level committee and the PDFs. Initially an extent of Ac. 177 cents covered in Sy. No. 121 of Mentada and Sy. No. 62 of NGR Puram of Ranasthalam mandal has been identified. But as per records and CRZ Survey most of the land is covered in the CRZ zone III area leaving very little extent for construction of R and R colony. In addition to the inadequate extent, the project affected people have not shown interest to shift south direction under their beliefs. Hence this option for locating R and R colony is not exercised. Another site was selected and proposed to project affected people at Sy.No. 2 covered with an approximate extent of Ac. 900.00 cts of Kondamulagam (V) of

Ranasthalam mandal. But the project affected people did not prefer the site as the site is far away from the coast and they cannot continue their profession.

Finally, the land covered in Sy. No. 551 to an extent of Ac. 88.00 and in Sy. No. 553 to an extent of 125.82 cts totally to an extent of 213.82 cts belongs to the forest department of Dharmavaram village of Etcherla Mandal has been identified for setting up R and R colony for the PDFs of Kovvada Andhra Pradesh Nuclear Power Project. All the 6 project affected villages have unanimously agreed to settle at Dharmavaram Village of Etcherla Mandal R and R facilities are provided as per provisions of New LARR Act 2013. And, the land measuring to an extent of 238.52 cts in Sy. No. 29-3 classified as Konda hill poramboke of Tamada village of Laveru mandal in the district belongs to revenue department has been identified in lieu of forest land to be handed over under compensatory afforestation to the forest department.
