No. 7402.- In exercise of the power conferred by section 3, sub-section (3) of the Ancient Monuments Preservation Act, of 1904, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council is pleased to declare the ancient monuments in Pargana Chaintpur in the Bhabua district, which are described in the following table, to be protected monuments within the meaning of that Act:-
