p	hort narrative of the proposal and project/schems for which the forest land equired	Khammampally to Bhupalapary 1000 to 26/0 is an important road pally, Pedda thundla from Km 0/0 to 26/0 is an important road connecting Malhar Rao mandal hqrs to Jayashankar Bhupalpally district hqrs.  This road is the shortest route to reach district hqrs and also shortest route to reach the coal belt areas of Manthini, Godavarikhani in Pedda pally district and Bhupalpally in Jayashankhar District further connects KTPP at Chelpur in Jayashankhar District . Improvement of this road helps in industrial growth in Pedda pally district and Jayashankhar District and also helps in carrying agricultural goods to the nearby marketing centers. This road also contributes in socioeconomic development of backward classes. The above road is a single lane road and the traffic intensity on this road is very high and causing much inconvenience to vehicular traffic.
