

### Certificate

This is to certify that, the proposed road from VR road to VKY samudram in Dakkili mandal in Venkatagiri Range is an admitted right of way ie cart track as per Gazette notifications of Velikalli (E) and Bheemavaram RFs and are existing prior to 1980. The details of rights of way in each RF as per gazette notifications are as fallows:

- 1) Bheemavaram RF, notified under Section 15 of AP Forest Act, 1967 vide GO Ms. No. 1849 Food & Agriculture (Forest-III) Dept. dt. 6-9-1967.**

**(b) The following cart tracks to a width of 18 feet are admitted as rights of way for men, cattle and vehicles.**

**1. Cart track from Velikallu to Veerakumarayacha Samudram. It enters the block between station No. 2 and 3 at a distance of 1010 links from station No. 2 and running in a North-Easterly direction for a distance of about 23 chains leaves the block between stations 5 and 6 at a distance of 650 links from station No. 5.**

- 2) Velikallu (East ) RF, notified under Section 15 of AP Forest Act, 1967 vide GO Ms. No. 2430 Food & Agriculture (Forest III) Dept. dt. 2-12-1967:**

**"B (a) Rights of way admitted within the block. The following cart tracks are admitted as rights of way to a width of twelve feet for men, cattle and vehicles.**

- (i) The cart track from Veerakumarayachasamudram to Velikallu. It enters the block between station No. 26 and 27 at a distance of 850 links from station No. 26 and running through the block in a westerly direction for a distance of about 4 furlongs leaves the block between station No. 40 and 41 at a distance of 1530 links from station No. 40."**

In the proposals, the user agency proposed to black top the road on widening the admitted width. Copies of the Section 15 Gazette notifications are enclosed.

# **BHEEMAVARAM FOREST BLOCK IN VENKATAGIRI TALUK OF NELLORE DISTRICT DECLARED AS A RESERVED FOREST.**

[G. O. Ms. No. 1849, Food and Agriculture, (Forest-III), 6th September 1967.]

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Forest Act, 1967 (Act I of 1967), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby declares the Forest land described in the schedule below (delineated in the map kept in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests) to be a reserved forest with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the *Andhra Pradesh Gazette*.

1. Cart Track from Velikala to Veerakumarayacha Samudram. It enters the block between station 2 and 3 at a distance of 1010 links from station No. 2 and running in a North-Easterly direction for a distance of about 25 chains leaves the block between stations 5 and 6 at a distance of 680 links from station No. 5.

2. Cart Track from Chakkavolu to Kothanapadu. It enters the block between station 61 and 62 at a distance of 400 links from station No. 61 and running in a South-westerly direction for a distance of about 92 chains leaves the block between stations 105 and 106 at a distance of 200 links from station No. 105.

3. Cart Track from Pathanalapadu to Sangana-palli. It enters the block between stations 113 and 114 at a distance of 400 links from station No. 113 and running in a North-westerly direction for a distance of about 150 chains leaves the block between stations 179 and 180 at a distance of 210 links from station No. 179.

4. Cart track from Vellavarajupalli to meet R.W. 3 above. It enters the block between stations 117 and 118 at a distance of 300 links from station 117 and runs in a northerly direction for a distance of about 16 chains to meet Pathanalapadu-Sangampalli cart track vide Right of way 3 above.

5. Cart Track from Naidupalem to Venkatagiri-Rapur Road. It enters the block between stations 138 and 139 at a distance of 210 links from station 138 and running in a North-westerly direction for a distance of about 100 chains leaves the block between stations 152 and 153 at a distance of 760 links from station No. 152.

B. (a) Rights of way admitted within the block. The following cart tracks are admitted as rights of way to a width of twelve feet for men, cattle and vehicles.

(i) The cart track from Veerakumarayachasamudram to Velikallu. It enters the block between Station Nos. 26 and 27 at a distance of 350 links from Station No. 26 and running through the block in a westerly direction for a distance of about 4 furlongs leaves the block between Station Nos. 40 and 41 at a distance of 1,530 links from Station No. 40.

(ii) The cart track from Singanapalle to Velikallu. It enters the block between Station Nos. 34 and 35 at a distance of 1,500 links from Station No. 34 and running through the block in a north-westerly direction for about 4,000 links leaves the block between Station Nos. 39 and 40 at a distance of 10 links from Station No. 39.

(b) The following foot paths are admitted as rights of way to a width of six feet for men and cattle only.

(i) The foot path from Siddavaram to Velikallu. It enters the block between Station Nos. 7 and 8 at a distance of 370 links from Station No. 7 (two links from Station No. 8) and running through the block in a southerly direction for a distance of about two furlongs leaves the block between Station Nos. 50 and 51 at a distance of 1,270 links from Station No. 50.

(ii) The foot path from Cherlopalle to Velikallu. It enters the block between Station Nos. 14 and 15 at a distance of 750 links from Station No. 14 and running through the block in a south-westerly direction for a distance of about three furlongs leaves the block between Station Nos. 46 and 47 at a distance of 2,080 links from Station No. 47.

(iii) The footpath from Veerakumarayachasamudram to Singanapalle. It enters the block between Stations Nos. 27 and 28 at a distance of 1,800 links from Station No. 27 and running through the block in a south-westerly direction for a distance of about 5½ furlongs and leaves the block between Stations Nos. 33 and 34 at a distance of 500 links from Station No. 33.
