

**NET PRESENT VALUE OF FOREST LAND PROPOSED FOR DIVERSION**

A proposal has been processed by this office for Mining Operation at Dholpani River for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 6.9 HA of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for Purely Mining Operation as per the approved Mining Plan and EC under Ultapani Range of this Division.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency falls under **Chirang RF** measuring total land (Mining Area + Road area) = **6.90 HA** of Forest Land. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is barest minimum required for the project and the ecological class of the proposed land is considered as ECO-CLASS-I.

As per Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change Notification Dated **6<sup>th</sup> January, 2022** regarding the rate of the Net Present Value (NPV) of Forest Land ECO-CLASS-I is considered at the approved rate of Rs. 1116900.00/ha, for Open Forest Category.

Hence the NPV for 6.90 HA =  $6.90 \times 1116900 = \text{Rs. } 77,06,610.00$
