






We, the undersigneds have carried out joint inspection of forest land proposed to be diverted to National Highway-21(New NH-03) for the construction of Manali bridge and approach road from existing NH to proposed bridge on NH-21 km 310/0. The said diversion falls partly in forest land. The requirement of land is tabulated as under:-



On the basis of said inspection, it is certified that the forest land proposed to be diverted is inescapable and all other alternatives for the purpose have been explored and the forest land proposed to be diverted is barest minimum. The proposed land contains trees, the list of which is being enclosed separately. The proposed land is not effected by any burial ground, public utility or public water body (spring). Therefore, the above land is recommended for the purpose of creation of proposed bridge.






