ARBITRARY GRID (Metres)

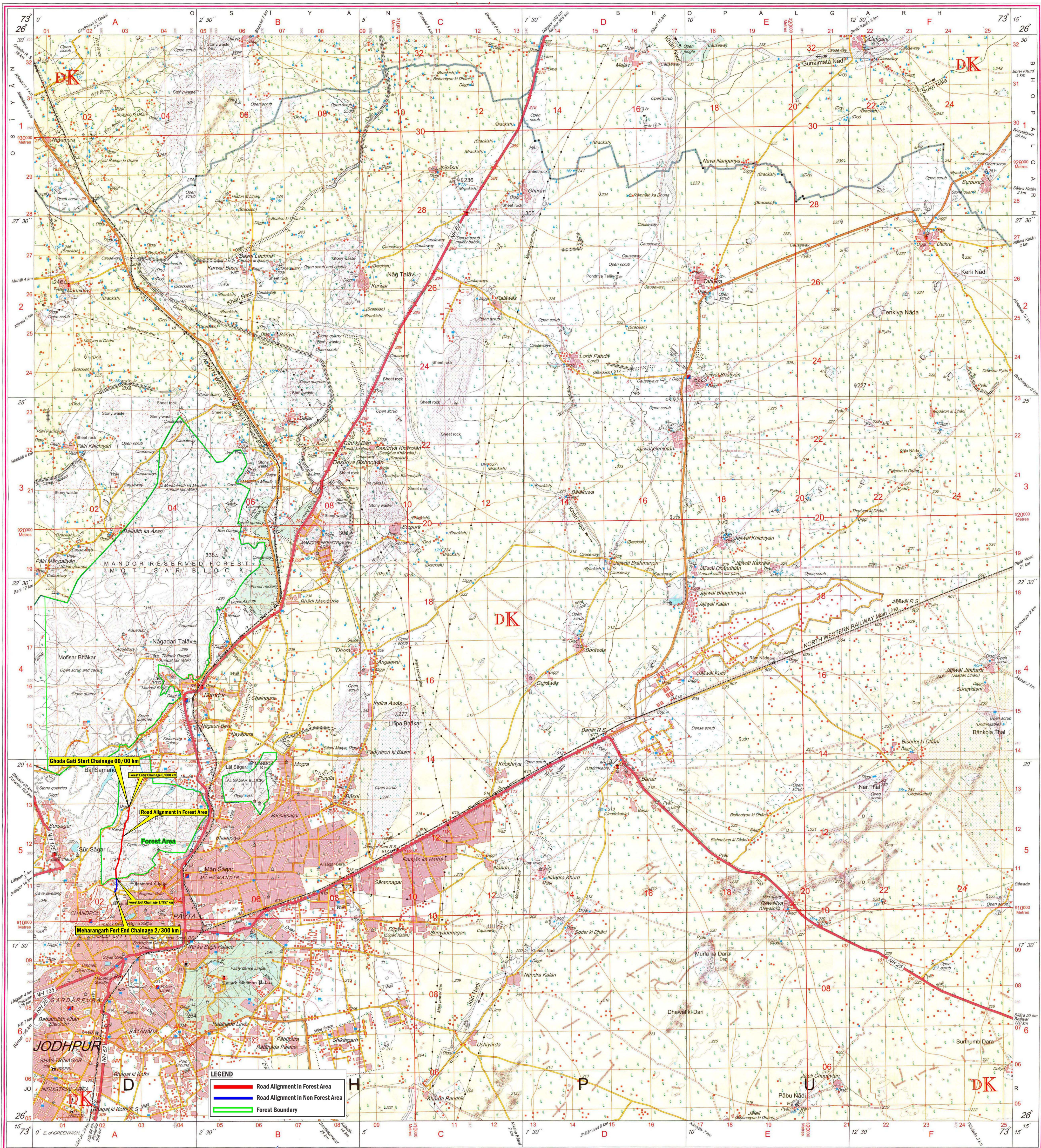
Arbitrary grid is drawn in red colour at an interval of 1 km.
