A proposal has been received by this office from PMGSY Division Kathua for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 1.38 ha. of forest land for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Diversion of Forest Land for construction of alternative road from Towara to Dodla. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 24/12/2021.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring 1.38 ha.


