(Treated as non-forest land in hal record) out of total forest land of 723.312 ha (including sabik kisam forest land of 238.093 ha) located within the ML hold area over 1586.36 ha. of Bolani Ores Mines (6.90 sq. miles) of Steel Authority of India Ltd. (SAIL) in village of Balagoda, Bolani, Limtur etc. and Karo Reserved forest under Barbil Tahasil of Keonjhar District, Odisha during 2<sup>nd</sup> RML period.

Dear Sir,

In reference with the subject cited above, we are submitting the point wise compliance of the observations of Forest Advisory Committee communicated vide letter under reference, as follows:

**Observation-1: On analysis through Decision Support System (DSS) and Land schedule given by State Government, it is learnt that there is township on over 20.795 ha Area. User Agency in its presentation observed that township is constructed before 1980. Documentary evidence for its construction prior to 1980 shall be submitted.**

As per the Land-use plan attached in DRP and as reasserted by MoEF, GOI through decision support system, that an area of 20.795 ha sabik kisam forest land has been broken under township head. As a matter of fact, Bolani Ores Mines was a single mining complex which later got separated to two mining leases and the instant lease was executed on 14.11.1962 for the purpose of mining of manganese ore and operation of infrastructural facilities, indispensable to despatch the iron ore produced from adjoining Bolani 5.1 sq. miles ML. The Order dated. 2nd/5th May 1958 of Deputy Secretary to Government, Govt. of Odisha approving the grant of Surface Rights and subsequent grant of Surface Rights by Collector, Keonjhar allowed for establishment of Staff and Labour housing (viz. Quarters/township) including other infrastructures. On the strength of such permissions, township was established. The following documentary evidences to that effect are attached for kind consideration:

- I. Copy of approval Order of Deputy Secretary to Government, Govt. of Odisha dt. 2nd/5th May 1958 for grant of Surface Right which allowed for establishment of staff / labour colony including other infrastructures (**Annexure-I**) and subsequent Surface Right Grant Orders of Collector, Keonjhar. (**Annexure-II**).
- II. The Quarter allotment orders of 1974-76 by the then M/s Bolani Ores Ltd, (the fore owner of Bolani Ores Mines, M/S SAIL copies attached in **Annexure-III** and Affiliation order for

DAV, Bolani School by Board of Secondary Education, Odisha. (**Annexure-IV**) very much indicates the existence of Township prior to 1980.

- III. The copy of composite plan (both 5.10 sq. mile & 6.90 sq. miles Mining Lease) of Bolani Ores limited dated. 26.08.1973 (**Annexure-V**) indicating Township including other infrastructural activities on it may be considered as a confirmatory evidence of existence of Township prior to 25.10.1980.

**Observation-2: Safety Zone of 2.687 ha has been reported to be broken. Action taken Report against the officials for the violation shall be submitted by the State Government.**

- I. The area of safety zone reported to be broken is 3.687 ha and not 2.687 ha. This is a typographical error & may be corrected.
- II. As submitted above, the aforesaid approval Order of Deputy Secretary to Government, Govt. of Odisha also allowed for establishment of workshops, layout of mine benches, construction of ore handling plant including other allied operations within the applied area covering 14.26 sq. miles which included both 5.10 sq. mile & 6.90 sq. mile Mining Lease. Accordingly, on depositing the royalty of forest growth on concerned areas, the required infrastructures were established (The proof of such payment of royalty is attached in **Annexure-VI**).
- III. Being a single mining complex during inception period, prior to the applicability of concept of Safety Zone under FC Act 1980, the aforesaid infrastructural facilities were created on the strength of Surface Right orders at different points of time before 1980 (as evidences provided in observation-1), extending over both the adjoining leases based on the convenience and suitability of land, which was beyond control of user agency and forest department.
- IV. The 3.687 Ha Sabik Kisam forest area broken up within safety zone belongs to this category of continuation/extension of those infrastructural facilities which will continue to be utilized for essential infrastructural facilities viz. road and conveyor Pipe line & HT/Power Line & continuity of existing plant and existing township without which the integrated system of production and dispatch will be disrupted leading to closure of both the mining projects of M/s SAIL.

**Observation- 3: In site inspection report (SIR) submitted by Regional Office it is reported that the total area has been mentioned 723.312 Ha in the proposal whereas total comes to 725.017 as per DGPS Survey and 744.233 ha as per revenue records. In this regard comments of State Government shall be sought.**

The difference in area was elaborated by State Govt. in F&E Dept. while forwarding the diversion proposal of 124.313 Ha sabik kisam forest land vide letter no 10F (Cons) 255/2016/15317/F&E dt 19.08.2016 under sl no -18 as follows:

\* N.B: - The Revenue Forest area of 166.93 ha as per previous Land schedule comes to 146.009 ha as per the DGPS surveyed ML boundary finalized during recent DGPS Survey jointly conducted by Mining , Revenue & Forest Dept. and authenticated by ORSAC. AS such the effective forest area as per revenue records (Govt. RoR) comes to 723.312 ha instead of 744.233 ha. As per the aforesaid jointly authenticated map the DGPS area of the said 723.312 ha is 725.017ha. with a difference of 0.23% (↑) which is within permissible limit.

In view of the above, we request you to kindly forward the compliance report to concerned authority for grant of Stage-I and Stage-II FC for the 124.313 hectares of Sabik Kissam forest land as on 25.10.1980 within 6.90 sq miles ML.

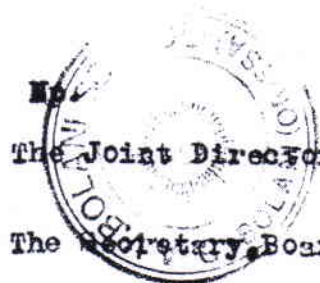

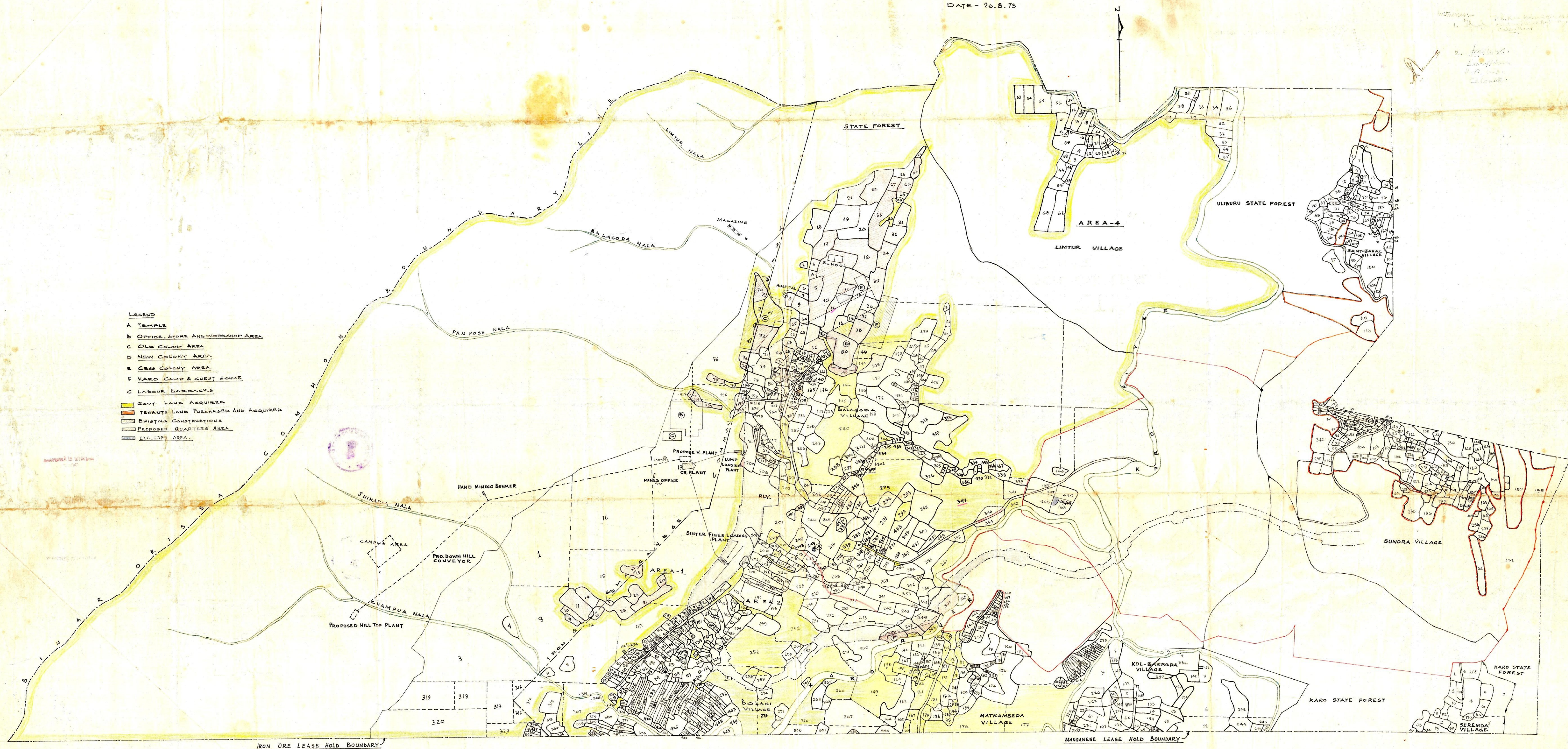
