3.	Adequacy of water availability not clear. Randomly some reports of 1987 and 1997 uploaded as annexures which are meaningless as at that point of time no projects were established in the vicinity.	The water availability detail has been given in the Hydrology details mentioned in TEC uploaded at Sr. No.25 against additional information of Part-I. As per Hydrology of the stream/khad, the Design Discharge is 2.07 cumecs and Flood Discharge is 715 cumecs. Further, un-related documents have been deleted from the addl. information of Part-I.
