
TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 205.481 hectares of forest land which comes under submergence in the Anjanagiri Reservoir, construction of Lift –I underground pumping station and construction of Tunnel between Anjanagiri Reservoir and Veeranjaneya Reservoir proposed to be diverted in favour of Irrigation & CAD Department, Executive Engineer, P.R.L.I.S Division No.1, Kollapur of P.R.L.I.S Circle No.1, Nagarkurnool in Nagarkurnool District falls within jurisdiction of Yellur and Narlapur villages of Kollapur Mandal and Paspula R.F.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 205.481 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure I to annexure III.
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest —Dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- (c) The each concerned Gram Sabha(s) have certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabhas of Yellur and Narlapur villages are enclosed as annexure I to annexure III.
- (d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of gram Sabha present;
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (f) The proposal does not involve recognised rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1) (e) of the FRA.

Minutes of Meeting on Submission of Forest Proposals held on 03.04.2017 in the chamber of the District Collector and Magistrate, Nagarkurnool.

Superintending Engineer, PRLIS explained about the project and about the land required as per the Preliminary Survey conducted by the department.

Since there was dispute between the land figures projected, It was agreed to conduct Joint survey with officials of PRLIS, Revenue, Forest and Survey Departments.

Assistant Director, Survey while explaining the details of the Joint Survey, stated that Joint Survey was conducted using Revenue, Survey records as well as feild measurement books of the Forest Department. Forest Gazette Notification was also verified and used while conducting the Survey.

Details of lands Jointly surveyed along with details as per the Forest Gazette Notification, and as per the requisition of PRLIS department are indicated in the table.

Assistant Director, Survey & Land Records informed that the alignment of the proposed project was taken into consideration and the forest land measurements from the field measurement book of the forest department, were re-laid on ground and accordingly the extent of forest land and revenue land in the alignment of PRLIS was arrived at in these (2) Villages.

Assistant Director, Survey & Land Records explained that during the Survey it was noticed that, in the Sy.No. 212 of Narlapur (V) of Kollapur (M) total extent of land is Ac14-23gts as against this forest land is Ac10-00 and Revenue land is Ac 4-23gts Total land required by PRLIS engineers is Ac 14-23gts therefore Ac 10-00 will be forest land and Ac 4-23gts will be Government land.

Similarly in Sy No.126 of Narlapur (V) of Kollapur (M) total extent of land is Ac 441-18gts against this Forest land is Ac 278-04gts and Government land is Ac163-16 Land required by PRLIS is Ac104-34gts as against this, Ac 36-00 is Forest land and Ac 68-34gts is Government Land.

In Sy. No.125 of Yellur (V) of Kollapur (M) total extent is Ac 163-39gts, as against this Ac 96-00 is Forest Land and Ac 67-39 is Government land. PRLIS requires Ac 108-16gts. in this Survey No. as against this requirement Ac 96-00 is forest land Ac 12-16gts is Government Land.

In Sy. No.176 the total extent is Ac 290-15gts, Forest land is Ac 97-00 and Government Land is Ac 193-15 Extent required by PRLIS in this Sy No. is Ac 290-15gts, therefore the entire land falls under PRLIS.

In Sy. No.399 of Yellore (V) of Kollapur (M) total extent is Ac 3616-08gts as against this, Forest land is Ac 3,420-30gts and the Government land is Ac 195-18gts. Extent of land required for PRLIS in this Survey is Ac 414-13 gts as against this Ac 267-21gts is forest land and Government Land is Ac146-32gts.

In these (2) Villages no other Survey Numbers or extents belonging to the Forest department are falling in the alignment of proposed Anjanagiri Reservoir, Construction of Stage-I Pumping Station of PRLIS.

It was also agreed that Revenue records shall be updated keeping in view the land notified as forest in the Forest Gazette, the joint survey was accepted by all the department present and agreed to proceed further as per this survey.

All the concerned officers were directed to take further action in the matter accordingly.
