

## **COMPENSATORY AFFORESTATION SCHEME**

NAME OF PROJECT: Estimate for compensatory afforestation scheme for diversion of 0.0116 ha forest land for installation of automatic data acquisition and real time data transmission system through satellite for rainfall water level and snow measurement at 17 th mmile Katao, Gurudongmar Lake, Yumesamdong, Dombang, Thangu, Yumthang valley, Dombang Ziro, Lachung, Samdong, Zema and Lachen in North Sikkim By CWC, Government of India.

1. INTRODUCTION: The CWC Government of India has proposed diversion of 0.0116 ha forest land for installation of automatic data acquisition and real time data transmission system through satellite for rainfall water lecel and snow measurement at 17 th mmile Katao, Gurudongmar Lake, Yumesamdong, Dombang, Thangu, Yumthang valley, Dombang Ziro, Lachung, Samdong, Zema and Lachen in North Sikkim By CWC, Government of India.

The Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India has prescribed the following guidelines for diversion:

- i. In all cases the legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- ii. User agency would have to pay the cost of Compensatory Afforestation to the State Forest Department.

## 3. INTEGRATED PROGRAMME / METHODOLOGY OF WORK EXECUTION

- Seedling Requirement: The requirement of seedlings may be met from the existing nurseries of the Department on payment basis as per the approved rates. The existing nurseries will have to be provided with the seeds of mixed species including the cost of nursery implements used.
- II. Choice of species: Mixed plantation of site-specific species indigenous fruit bearing and timber able species namely, Alnus nepalensis, Betula alnoides, Michelia excels, Magnolia lanuginosa, Quercus spp, Schima wallichii, Choero spondias axillaris, etc.
- III. Executing Agency: the works under the Scheme shall be executed by the of Forest and Environment Department, Government of Sikkim through Mangan Territorial Division under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, as per the approval of the Government.

IV. Monitoring and Evaluation: all the activities under the Scheme may be monitored by a committee constituted for the purpose, Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the representative from Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India concurrently and regularly.
