2.0 The project has been initiated by Mr. Rajendra Narnaware, Chief Manager (Construction) of M/s. GAIL (India) Limited, Nagpur for seeking approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for laying of underground Natural Gas Pipeline of Nagpur to Jharasguda along with Optical Fiber Cable passing through, Nagpur, Bhandara and Gondia (MH/MP Border) in the State of Maharashtra (PART-I, P/13)

3.00 Following documents as prescribed in Government Circular, Revenue and Forest Department No.FLD-1081/2041/(A)/F-3,dated 20/03/1982 and according to Government of India's instructions issued from time to time are enclosed in two copies.

**4.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nagpur, Bhandara and Gondia have certified that:-**

4.1 The total non-forest involved in project is 327.9925 ha. (Part-I, P/1)

4.2 (i) The site inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nagpur Forest Division, Nagpur is enclosed on page No.236 to 237. (Part-I)

4.6 The area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc. ( Part-I, P/219,220 ) (Part-II, P/22)

- 4.7 The proposed pipeline is passing in Pinch Point of EVL showing village Charbha, Kandala and Navegaon in Taluka Mauda is in Wildlife Corridor between Pench Tiger Reserve/Umred Karhandla Wildlife Sanctuary and Pinch Point map of Tiger Corridor of Eastern Vidarbha Landscape. **(Part-I, P/219)**
- 4.8 The project area affects the Tiger Corridor of Eastern Vidarbha Landscape (EVL) identified by WII, Dehradun near Village Dewhada (Khurd), Tal. Mohadi, Dist. Bhandara. **(Part-I, P/220)**
- 4.9 The proposed gas pipeline through 25 villages which fall either under NTCA's Corridor map or WII's Eastern Vidarbha Landscape (EVL) Tiger Corridor Atlas. **(P/22 to 24) (Part-II)**
- 4.10 Proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance. **(Part-I, P/215, 216) (Part-II, P/50)**
- 4.11 (i) There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. **(Part-I, P/208 & 206)**
- (ii) The Deputy Conservator of Forests; Gondia has certified that there is violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The detail of violation report is enclosed on page No. 1 to 8 **(Part-II)**
- 4.12 (i) Proposed project is beyond 10 Kms. of the boundary of the Protected Area (Sanctuary and National Park) **(Part-I, P/229 & P/230).**
- (ii) Proposed project is 11.900 Km from the nearest aerial distance point of Nagzira Wildlife Sanctuary (C.No.116) is part of the Navegaon Nagzira Tiger Reserve, Gondia **(Part-II, P/13)**
- 4.13 The non-forest area covered under the project is not under the provision of Maharashtra Private Forest (Acquisition) Act 1975 by virtue of application of Section 35 of Indian Forest Act 1927 and are not recognized as deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area identified as "forest" as per dictionary meaning of forest as intimated to the expert committee appointed under interim judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996 **(Part-I, P/212, 213 & 214).**
- 4.14 Proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 21.00 ha. degraded forest land in Compt No.271 RF, at Village Lakhandur, Tal. Lakhandur, Dist. Bhandara and it is contiguous, suitable for afforestation and management purpose and it is free from encroachment and an encumbrances. **(Part-II, P/67).**



**5.0 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-**

- 5.1 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value (P/277) (Part-I)
- 5.2 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Compensatory Afforestation (P/275) (Part-I)
- 5.3 The User Agency has submitted to provide the non-forest land for compensatory afforestation before Stage-II approval. (File P/186)
- 5.4 The User Agency has submitted Cross Section Map is enclosed herewith on page No.294 (Part-I)
- 5.5 The User Agency has submitted a copy of the administrative approval is enclosed on page No.285 (Part-I)
- 5.6 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking regarding the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before final approval as per Government of India vide letter No.11-43/2013-FC, dt.03/12/2018 (P/282).(Part-I)
- 6.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nagpur, Bhandara and Gondia and the Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Nagpur has recommended the revised proposal for diversion of 9.4715 ha. of Forest land with the conditons of SBWL sanction. (Part-I, P/28 to 35) & (Part-II, P/15 to 16)

**2.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –**

**2.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.**

**2.2 Compensatory Afforestation :-**

- a) Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 21.00 ha. degraded forest land in Compt No.271 RF, at Village Lakhandur, Tal. Lakhandur, Dist. Bhandara at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.

**2.3 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.**

## 2.4 NPV:-

- a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 9.4715 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
  - b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- 2.5 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 2.6 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<http://parivesh.nic.in/>)
- 2.7 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- 2.8 The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- 2.9 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 2.10 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 2.11 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 2.12 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 2.13 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 2.14 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.




- 2.15 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
- 2.16 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 2.17 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 2.18 The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>)

3.0 This office vide letter dated 25/01/2024 & 21/03/2024 has informed to the CF (T), Nagpur and User Agency to provide details of Non-Forest land for compensatory afforestation. The said proposal is monitored by the PMG/Pragati meeting. So, the aforesaid proposal is considered as a special case. The User Agency has already submitted undertaking for the same. In this context, the proposal submitted for consideration of prior approval of Government of India.

4.0 Keeping in view facts mentioned in above para this proposal for proposal is for diversion of 6.4325 ha. (Revised area 9.4715 ha.) Forest land for laying of underground Natural Gas pipeline along with Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) Stretch of Nagpur to Jharasguda Pipeline passing through district Nagpur, Bhandara and Gondia (Maharashtra Border) in the State of Maharashtra has been initiated by the GAIL India Limited. is recommended for approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

- 4.6 The area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc. (Part-I, P/219,220) (Part-II, P/22)
- 4.7 The proposed pipeline is passing in Pinch Point of EVL showing village Charbha, Kandala and Navegaon in Taluka Mauda is in Wildlife Corridor between Pench Tiger Reserve/Umred Karhandla Wildlife Sanctuary and Pinch Point map of Tiger Corridor of Eastern Vidarbha Landscape. (Part-I, P/219)
- 4.8 The project area affects the Tiger Corridor of Eastern Vidarbha Landscape (EVL) identified by WII, Dehradun near Village Dewhada (Khurd), Tal. Mohadi, Dist. Bhandara. (Part-I, P/220)
- 4.9 The proposed gas pipeline through 25 villages which fall either under NTCA's Corridor map or WII's Eastern Vidarbha Landscape (EVL) Tiger Corridor Atlas. (P/22 to 24) (Part-II)

4.13 The non-forest area covered under the project is not under the provision of Maharashtra Private Forest (Acquisition) Act 1975 by virtue of application of Section 35 of Indian Forest Act 1927 and are not recognized as deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area identified as "forest" as per dictionary meaning of forest as intimated to the expert committee appointed under interim judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996 (Part-I, P/212, 213 & 214).

4.14 Proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 21.00 ha. degraded forest land in Compt No.271 RF, at Village Lakhandur, Tal. Lakhandur, Dist. Bhandara and it is contiguous, suitable for afforestation and management purpose and it is free from encroachment and an encumbrances. (Part-II, P/67).

5.6 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking regarding the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before final



approval as per Government of India vide letter No.11-43/2013-FC, dt.03/12/2018 (P/282).(Part-I)

6.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nagpur, Bhandara and Gondia and the Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Nagpur has recommended the revised proposal for diversion of 9.4715 ha. of Forest land with the conditons of SBWL sanction. (Part-I, P/28 to 35) & (Part-II, P/15 to 16)

2.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: -

2.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.

2.2 Compensatory Afforestation :-

a) Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 21.00 ha. degraded forest land in Compt No.271 RF, at Village Lakhandur, Tal. Lakhandur, Dist. Bhandara at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.

2.3 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.


2.4 NPV:-

- a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 9.4715 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.

- 2.5 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 2.6 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<http://parivesh.nic.in/>)
- 2.7 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- 2.8 The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- 2.9 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 2.10 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 2.11 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 2.12 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 2.13 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 2.14 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 2.15 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
- 2.16 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 2.17 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 2.18 The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>)

3.0 This office vide letter dated 25/01/2024 & 21/03/2024 has informed to the CF (T), Nagpur and User Agency to provide details of Non-Forest land for compensatory afforestation. The said proposal is monitored by the PMG/Pragati meeting. So, the aforesaid proposal is considered as a special case. The User Agency has already submitted undertaking for the same. In this context, the proposal submitted for consideration of prior approval of Government of India.

4.0 Keeping in view facts mentioned in above para this proposal for proposal is for diversion of 6.4325 ha. (Revised area 9.4715 ha.) Forest land for laying of underground Natural Gas pipeline along with Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) Stretch of Nagpur to Jharasguda Pipeline passing through district Nagpur, Bhandara and Gondia (Maharashtra Border) in the State of Maharashtra has been initiated by the GAIL India Limited. is recommended for approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
