Yes recommended, The proposed pipeline is very essential for their hatchery for drawing sea water from Bay of Bengal to Shrimp hatchery. There is no violation of work taken place. The required forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of flora and fauna and no protected archeological importance in this locality. The proposal is recommended with following certain

conditions in the interest of forest and wildlife conservation.

- 1. Display board at starting and ending point showing details of forest land involved in diversion and clearly mentioning the status of land as "Forest land".
- 2. All the material required for pipeline work shall brought from outside and no material shall be collected from Reserve forest reserve land.
- 3. All DGPS surveyed points shall be clearly demarcated on the field and proposed alignment shall be followed.
- 4. Underground pipeline have to be covered properly and it should not be visible from outside.
- 5.The effluents shall be discharged after proper treatment as per approval by the competent authority.
- 6. In any case treated effluents shall not be released into forest area.
