

VIOLATION REPORT

The R&B NH Division, Warangal has submitted a proposal widening & Strengthening of existing road to 2 lane with paved shoulders from Km 25/0 to 59/2 of Mahadevpur to Bhupalpally in Bhupalpally Division to and extent of **18.4282 Ha** (Diversion area 21.4682 Ha – 3.04 Ha (existing right of way) = 18.4282 Ha).



Further, the R&B NH Division, has Violated by Illegal excavation of soil in the proposed area. The area of violation is as follows as per POR.

But the user agency failed to obtain prior permission from the Forest Department. After verification of reply given the R&B NH Division, Warangal, the under signed has compounded for Rs. 79,695/- and paid by the User Agency on 03.04.2019 (copy enclosed).

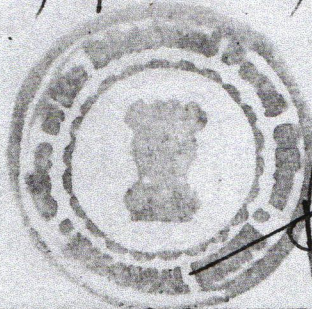

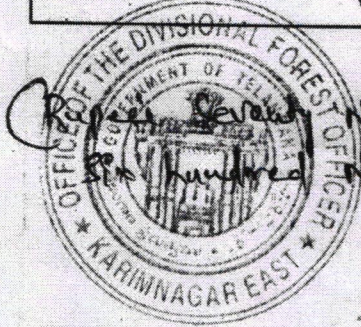
