- I, Anurag Tripathi, AGM-Slurry Pipeline Project on behalf of M/s Jindal Steel & Power Ltd., certify that, in case approval under the Act for diversion of forest land is declined, it is technically not feasible to execute the project involving diversion of forest land due to the following reasons:
 - 1. The length of the pipeline route from Barbil to Angul is 198.60 Km. We have studied three alternative routes considering barest minimum forest length. The results of the study indicate that alternate-I had the barest minimum Forest length of 17.183 Km. The forests cannot be avoided. Hence, there is no alternate alignment without forests.
