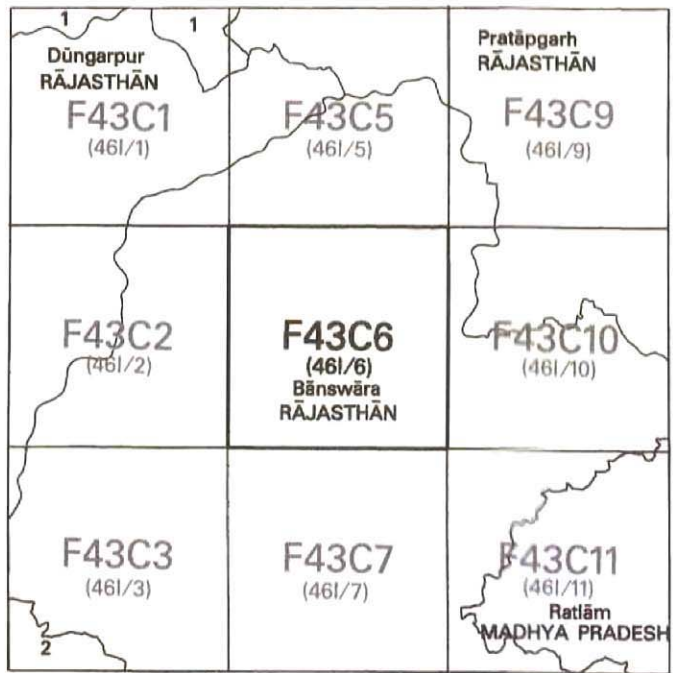

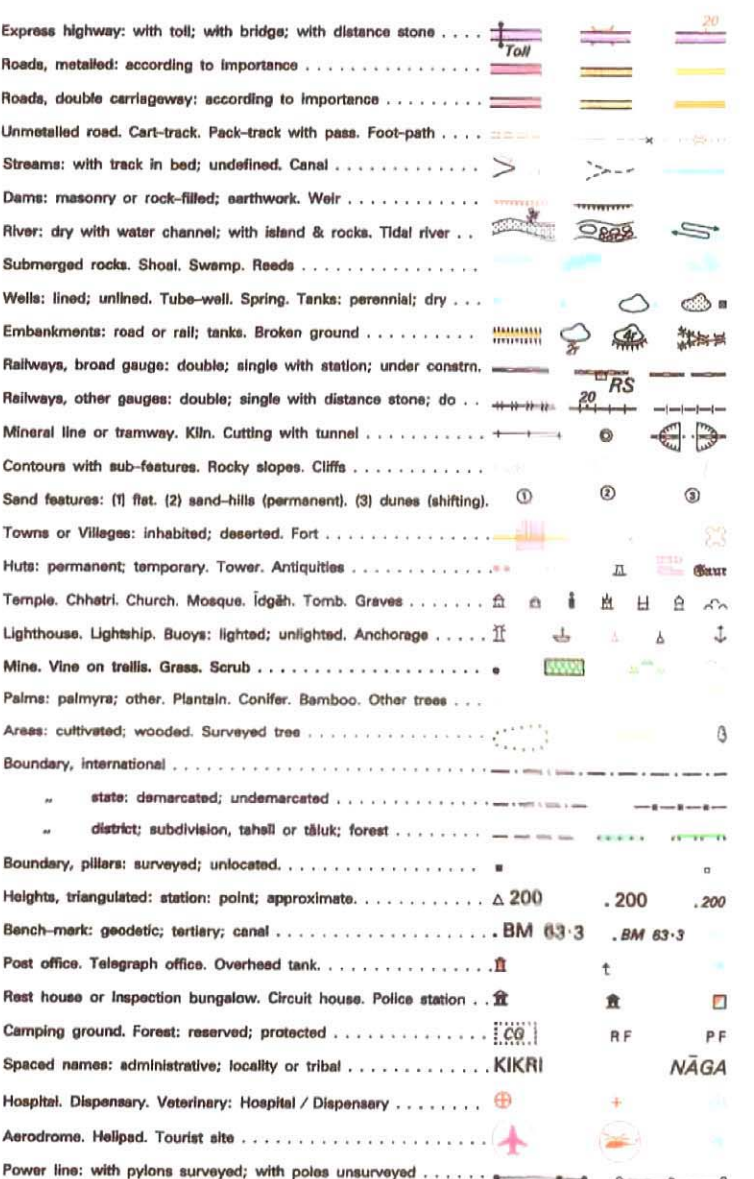

Canal distance shown are 1000 feet apart and every fifth stone is numbered.
Collection in periods and dependent on rainfall.
Unlaid wells are numerous in the cultivated portion of this sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
The flow in this sheet is generally from June to November.
Digul is a tank which is used for collection of water.

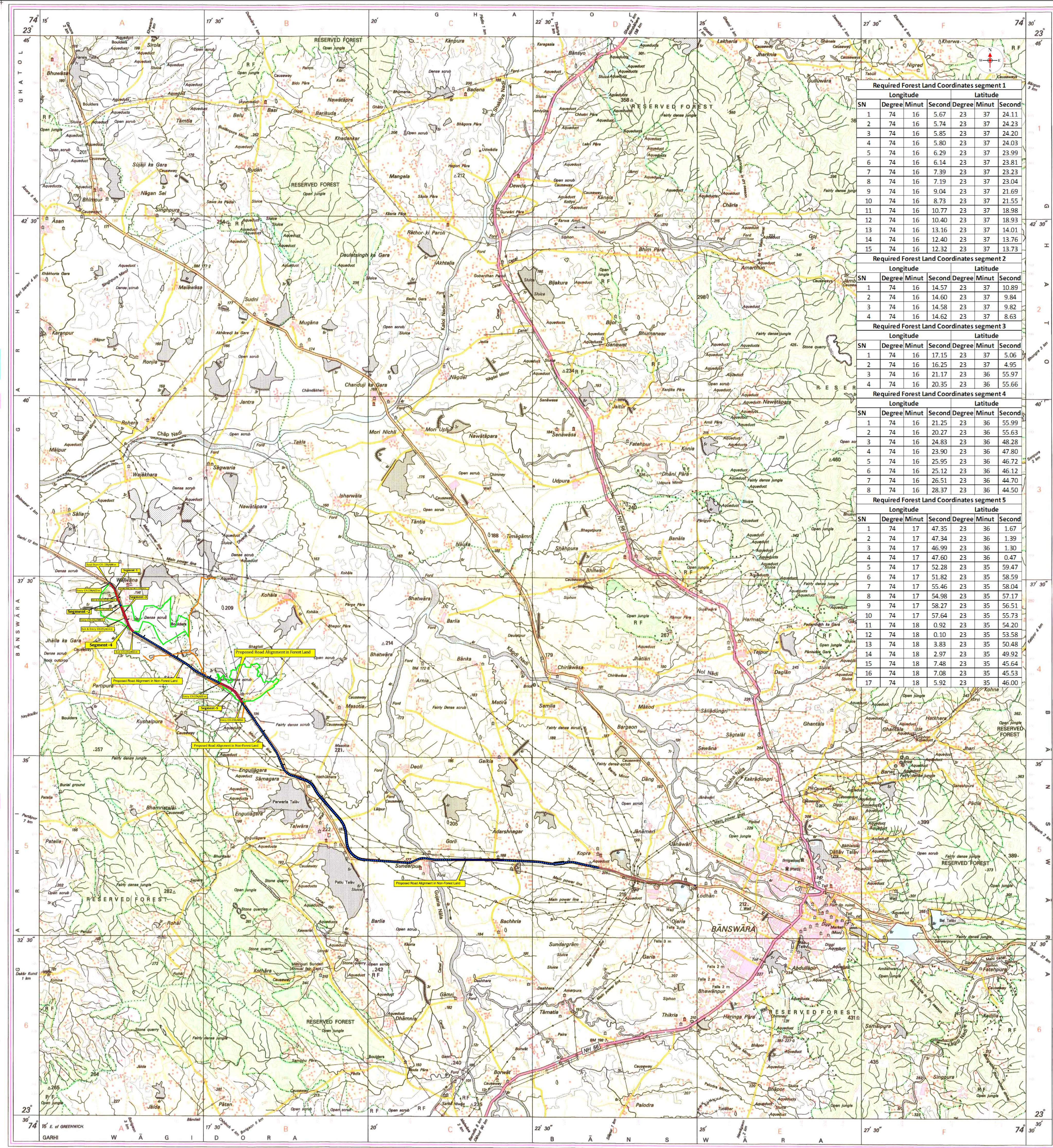

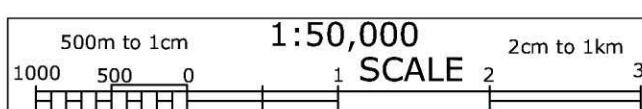
