Emergency landing facility on highway requires state portion of highway, gradient (<1.5%) availability of alternative route (used by road users in emergency landing) along the proposed site landing facility, are required, which are found on NH-15 near km 200.600 to km 205.600 in Eka, Ramdevra, Viramdevra (Jaisalmer). This site has been selected by joint inspection of officials of Indian Air Force, Ministry of Defense and NHAI.
