Inspected the forest area proposed for diversion in Compartment No. 132 & 133 of Mangalagiri block in Tadepalli Reserve Forest in Mangalagiri Beat and Section of Guntur Range along with the Divisional Electrical Engineer, Operation town –II, APSPDCL, Guntur on 18.05.2017. 0.794Ha Forest land is proposed for diversion in favour of the Divisional Electrical Engineer, Operation town –II, APSPDCL, Guntur for shifting of power lines away from AIIMS Campus and obstructing the approach road from National High way to AIIMS Campus at Mangalagiri.

**Classification**

The proposed area falls in Tropical Dry Deciduous Forests classified as Eco-Class III, open / Scrub forest as per ecological classes.

**Topology**

The area is covered with cliffs. The terrain is gentle slope.

**Density of vegetation**

The density of vegetation is 0.2. The proposed area is having species like Jana, Narlengi, Tellatumba and neem.

**Flora and Fauna**

No endangered flora and fauna species found in the area except the following species detailed below.


